



Check-in assessment for Years 7, 8 & 9

Dear parents and carers,

All students will participate in a reading and numeracy Check-in assessment.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

- The assessment is scheduled for all students during Term 4, Weeks 6 and 7.
- Each test runs for approximately 50 minutes. Students will be provided with a timetable for the tests.

Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment that they would normally receive in the classroom.

Earphones: Students are to bring headphones or earbuds that plug into a computer to enable them to hear audio during the assessment. Earbuds used for mobile phones or other portable devices may be suitable for use during the assessment. The type of computer connection needed is a jack or USB. Students that do not bring in earphones will still be able to read and access the tests without disruption.
