



Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> of March, Oran Park High School will be celebrating Harmony Day to coincide with our fortnightly assembly. Harmony Day celebrates Australia's cultural diversity. It's about inclusiveness, respect and a sense of belonging for everyone. This year's theme is Everyone Belongs.

On this day, students are permitted to attend school wearing an **orange top with normal school bottoms, normal school uniform or sports uniform**. If students wish to wear cultural clothing and participate in the parade on assembly, they will be permitted to change for the assembly.

The following guidelines apply to Harmony Day at Oran Park High School:

- The theme of the day is **Orange top (normal school bottoms), Sports Uniform or Normal School Uniform** to support Harmony Day.
- Despite the change in clothing and additional activities, the school day is a normal one. Normal TRAK rules apply.
- Students must not wear clothes which contain offensive slogans, pictures or words, political messages, or any design which may cause offence.
- Students must wear clothes that are safe and appropriate for a normal school day e.g. overly revealing clothes such as micro minis, midriff/crop tops and ripped jeans/pants will not be permitted.
- Student's shoes must be joggers or normal school shoes.
- Students wishing to bring **Cultural Clothing** and participate in the Parade of Nations on assembly can change prior to assembly and can change back after assembly.
