Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Tuesday 20 May, Oran Park High School will be holding a Multicultural Day assembly. Multicultural Day celebrates Australia's cultural diversity. It is about inclusiveness, respect, and a sense of belonging for everyone. On this day **only**, students **are permitted** to attend school wearing traditional cultural clothing or a cultural jersey.

The following guidelines apply to Multicultural Day at Oran Park High School:

- Students can wear **traditional cultural clothing** (see safety exclusions below) **or** if wearing a **cultural jersey** must wear full school uniform on the bottom.
- **Safety Exclusions:** Overly revealing clothes such as micro minis, midriff/crop tops and ripped jeans/pants, offensive slogans, pictures or words, political messages, designs which may cause offence. Bare feet, thongs, open-toed shoes, crocs, sandals, and heels **will not be permitted in the school**.
- Students **must** be prepared for any practical lessons (Science, PE, TAS) including enclosed leather shoes.

During the rest of the week the leadership team have organised some other multicultural activities such as a food stall on Wednesday and activities in the playground during break times on Thursday normal school uniform will apply on these days.

We look forward to sharing our Multicultural Day celebrations with our school community.
