Continuity of Learning Plan for Students/Parents



To ensure continuity of learning for students we have:

1. Google Classroom for all subjects

Students have been instructed on how to use Google Classroom and their school email effectively. All staff have also been instructed on how to provide class work through google classroom to ensure continuity of student learning.

An information sheet on joining Google Classroom is attached.

2. Continuity of Learning Timetable for Students

Attached is a timetable for all students to follow whilst they are working from home or school. The times allocated on the timetable are when teachers from those faculty areas will be online answering questions, updating work and providing feedback. Students are still able to access work outside of these times and ask questions but this is the best time for teacher support. Outside of these times teachers will programming, marking, planning and undergoing professional learning.

3. Disability Support

Our disability support students will be working on StudyLadder for Support students, Maths Prodigy Platform and See Saw. A package was sent to parents last week with information about these platforms.
